## Cooling down

Yesterday's cold front made some noise passing through the Washington area. We spent most of the afternoon and evening under severe thunderstorm watches. And there were numerous heavy showers and thunderstorms. That threat has passed well to the east, and now more pleasant weather will return to the region. Skies will remain partly to mostly cloudy through this morning but will start clearing during the afternoon. It will be breezy and cooler with highs in the mid- to upper 60s. Mostly clear skies are expected tonight with lows in the 40s. Tomorrow looks much brighter, with mostly sunny skies and afternoon high temperatures near 70 degrees. By Sunday, more cloudiness will return, and there is a slight chance of a passing shower during the afternoon.



Computer models support the forecast of some pretty pleasant weather around here next week. In fact, if the weather works out the way I think it will, we will be treated to another stretch of classic autumn weather. Monday through Thursday looks dry with partly sunny skies. Daytime temperatures will be in the lower 70s on Monday and slowly climb a little each day thereafter. By Thursday, highs should be in the upper 70s. Four straight days of partly sunny, warm weather — that's why I call it classic autumn weather.

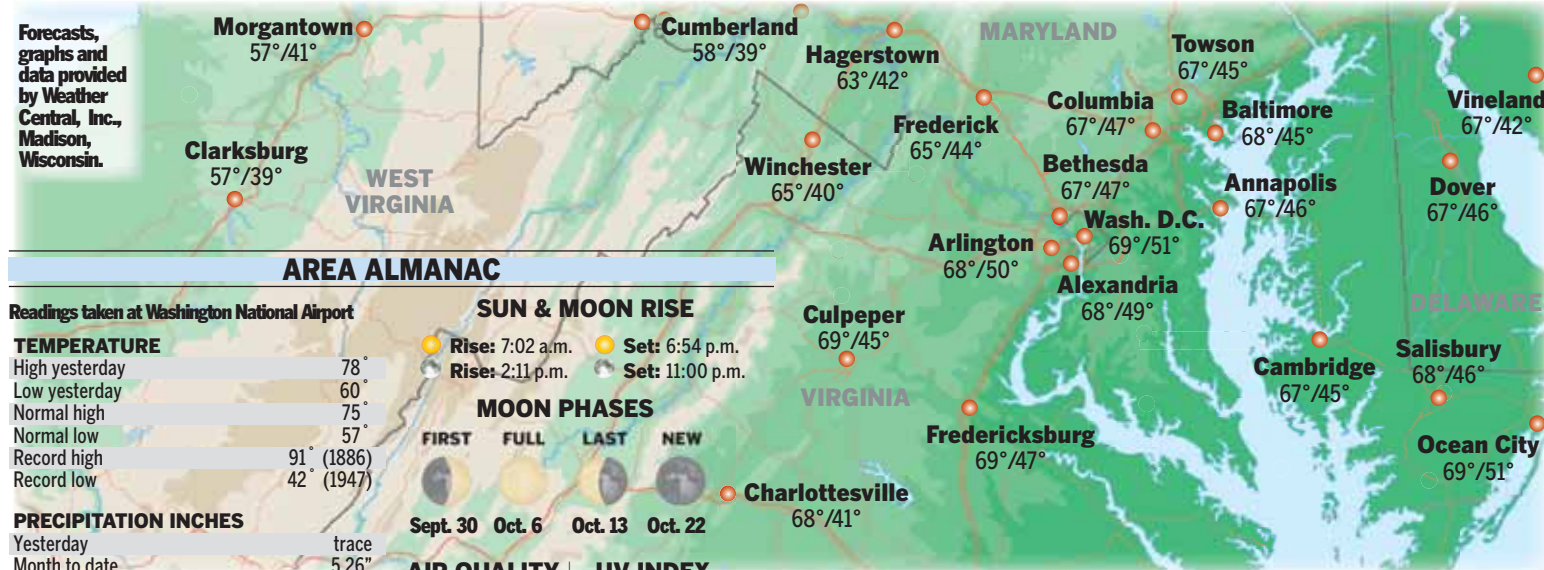
### CALIFORNIA

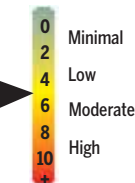

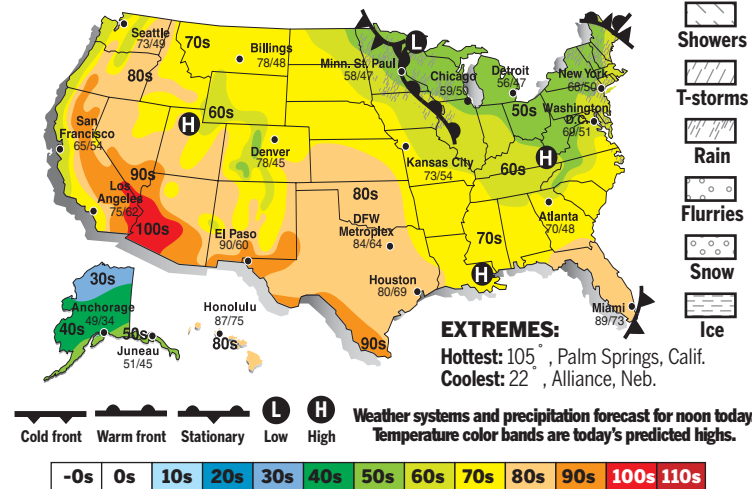
